### **Guidelines**

#### The Basics

- This document is subject to change as COVID 19 Commonwealth of MA Restrictions change.
- Please follow Parking Lot Attendants for directions to your parking space.
- You must view the movie from within your vehicle (Massachusetts Requirement, no outside Chairs at this time, except in the bed of pickup trucks)
- Cars cannot be directly next to each other even if part of same quarantine unit. You will be parked away from a neighboring car to allow for social distancing.
- Parking lights only when entering the parking lot! Please review your car manual for instructions on shutting off any "daytime" running lights.
- Out of respect for other attendees and the environment you cannot run/idle your vehicle engine during movies, even if it gets really hot or really cold.
- Alcohol, of any kind, smoking, vaping in or near your vehicle is strictly prohibited. Doing such is grounds for immediate removal and will forfeit your right to register for future movies.
- All trash is carry in and carry out
- Even if you arrive very early, we reserve the right to make you switch spaces with another vehicle if another view of the screen is blocked. We can't promise you the perfect parking space and we hope to provide a fair viewing experience for all in attendance.
- Masks or face coverings must be worn when walking to the ice cream truck or bathroom, and we ask that all attendees observe social distancing when in line for ice cream or food.
- You cannot bother your neighbors in any unreasonable way. If Parking Lot Attendants determine that you're bothering neighbors, you'll be asked to leave.

## Parking

- Park only in the designated parking spots, our Parking Lot Attendants have the final destination decision and you may be asked to move or re-park.
- Park your vehicle in height appropriate designated rows.
- If your vehicle seats are low to the ground, we recommend parking in the first four rows closest to the movie screen.
- Height includes your raised hatch or anything that causes the top of your vehicle to be close to 6 feet or 6 ½ feet off the ground
- Hatches must be tied down, at least one inch below roof, immediately upon arrival. Our parking lot attendants provide string and help; please let us know if you need assistance.

## WATCHING THE FILM

- Attendees may watch the film:
  - seated in their cars with the windows rolled up,
  - seated in their cars with the windows rolled down, or
  - sitting on truck beds or off a tailgate.

Please adhere to COVID 19 Commonwealth of MA Restrictions and social distancing regulations.

- Audio will be broadcast through an FM Transmitter (through your own car radio). If your car does not have FM radio, we recommend bringing a digital FM portable radio with you to the event. We can't provide them for you.
- Vehicles will be appropriately parked according to size.

## FAQ

**What are COVID-19 guidelines?** Due to the changing situation and regulations in Massachusetts, the Guidelines and FAQ may be adjusted for safety. We ask that you follow all the rules that our Parking Lot Attendants asks of you.

**Do you have restrooms?** Yes, there will be a portable bathroom on-site.

**Can I leave and come back?** Yes, if you need to leave and come back you can do so however you will not be guaranteed to park in your original spot.

**When should I get there?** You must arrive at least 30 minutes before the movie to guarantee a space, the ICNE lot will open to attendees 1 hour before the movie.

**Can I bring alcohol?** No, you can't bring beer, wine, or any alcohol. Doing such is grounds for immediate removal and will forfeit your right to register for future movies.

**My vehicle has daytime running lights; what do I do?** Please consult your owner's manual before coming to the drive-in and make sure you know how to turn them off so you won't bother your neighbors. If you can't shut off lights, our employees may block lights.

**Will my car battery die?** Put your car in the ACC (accessory) position to avoid draining your battery, see your manual before you arrive.

**How do I hear the movies?** Movie sound will be on your car radio or any digital FM portable radio. Movie sound is not on the internet.

**What not to bring?** We do not allow alcohol, smoking devices, weapons, grills, coolers, kids' electric vehicles, or anything our Parking Lot Attendants think could cause a problem in terms of safety or bothering other customers.

**Are movies still shown in the rain?** They can be; however, we reserve the right to cancel.

**Can we use lawn chairs?** No. COVID 19 Commonwealth of MA Restrictions prevent lawn chairs outside of your vehicle at this time, unless you are seated in the bed of a pickup truck.
