### KAYAK RACK PERMIT RULES & REGULATIONS

- Permit Fee is: Handicap/Top \$90, Middle \$120, Lower \$150 for the current season (May 15th-October 15th)
- There will be permits available for 108 personal watercraft devices for the season and 8 handicap slots (must show handicap parking tag to be issued permit.)
- You will be **assigned** a specific location based on your purchase where to store your watercraft.
- One slot can fit **two** personal single kayaks or two SUPs **OR** one two person kayak or one canoe. One slot *per household* may be purchased.
- It is the responsibility of the owner to supply and secure the personal watercraft with cable and locks.
- Your sticker must be adhered to your kayak on the front of the boat where it can be seen when your boat is on the kayak rack.
- Items left after **October 15th** will become property of the Sharon Recreation Department and **late pick up fee** of \$50 **per month** will apply. In addition, those who fail to pick up their watercraft in a timely manner will not be permitted to participate in the program in future years.
- Watercrafts illegally stored are subject to impounding and a \$50 fine.
- The Town of Sharon is not responsible for any vandalism, theft or personal injury by/of kayaks.
- Individuals must sign this form when they register for boat access sticker.
- If you lose your permit then you must contact the Sharon Recreation Department to obtain a new one. There is a \$5 fee for a replacement sticker
- You may not place your kayak on the storage racks without an active permit on it.
- Kayak permits are issued to Sharon residents only. **Individuals must purchase a car or walk-in pass to enter Veterans' Memorial Park Beach. For summer 2023, beach pass is not required at Community Center Beach.**
- Please follow all boating safety rules and regulations. Individuals using kayaks, SUP and canoes must have a distress whistle and US Coast Guard approved PFD must be worn.
- Kayak rack spaces can only be used by the person the permit was issued to. Anyone found violating this policy will lose their kayak rack space permanently.
