

# STUDENT PARKING

## Who is eligible to purchase a student parking permit?

There are 110 spots for the Senior Lot on Pond Street and 90 spaces available at the right side of Veterans' Memorial Park Beach designated for Juniors. Please register for the proper lot, based on your grade.

## When do parking permits go on sale?

Students may register to purchase a season pass **one week prior** to the start of the school year. An email will be sent from the Principal of Sharon High School through **SWIFTK12**, part of the Power School software application, alerting the students of the registration date each year. **Permits are limited.** Once permits are sold out, students must find alternative arrangements as parking is not guaranteed.

## I have registered. Now how do I get my permit?

In order to register for a parking permit, you must have an account set up on **SharonRec.com**.

Permits may be picked up at Sharon Recreation Department during normal business hours. Students may **NOT** park in their designated lot until their decal is properly affixed to their vehicle.

## Where do I place my permit?

Affix your window cling inside the **REAR DRIVERS SIDE WINDOW**. This will not obstruct your vision. Plate number **MUST** match license plate on the permit or you will be subject to a ticket. Only one plate per student is permitted.

## What happens if I get a new vehicle?

If you need a new permit for a change of plate or vehicle, there will be a \$10 replacement fee. The old permit must be returned.

## HELP! I have a need for a temporary permit.

**NEW!** If you need a temporary permit, please visit the Sharon Recreation Department during normal business hours. A temporary pass will be issued for ONE week, for those experiencing extenuating circumstances.

Temporary permits will be \$10. Be sure have it visibly located in the same location as your decal to avoid a parking ticket.

## Inclement Weather

Please note: these lots are not always plowed immediately. DPW does its best to get to it but main roads and school lots take priority.

## If there are no parking spots remaining, can I park on the left side of the beach or at the boat launch?

No. Parking at the Boat Launch requires a visible parking permit, year-round. Our community enjoys the beach during all seasons. Parking is limited on the left side of the lot (towards Pond Street) for up to three hours maximum. If you park in those locations, you will receive a parking violation.

## Parking Restrictions

Unfortunately, we cannot pave or line the lot at this time. For safety reasons, please do not park four car widths between the grass (shed side) and first parking spot to allow access for emergency vehicles. We appreciate your cooperation!
